## REALITY:

Under existing guidelines, globally  
14 million people need treatment,  
fewer than four million have it.

an additional 110,000 are infected.”

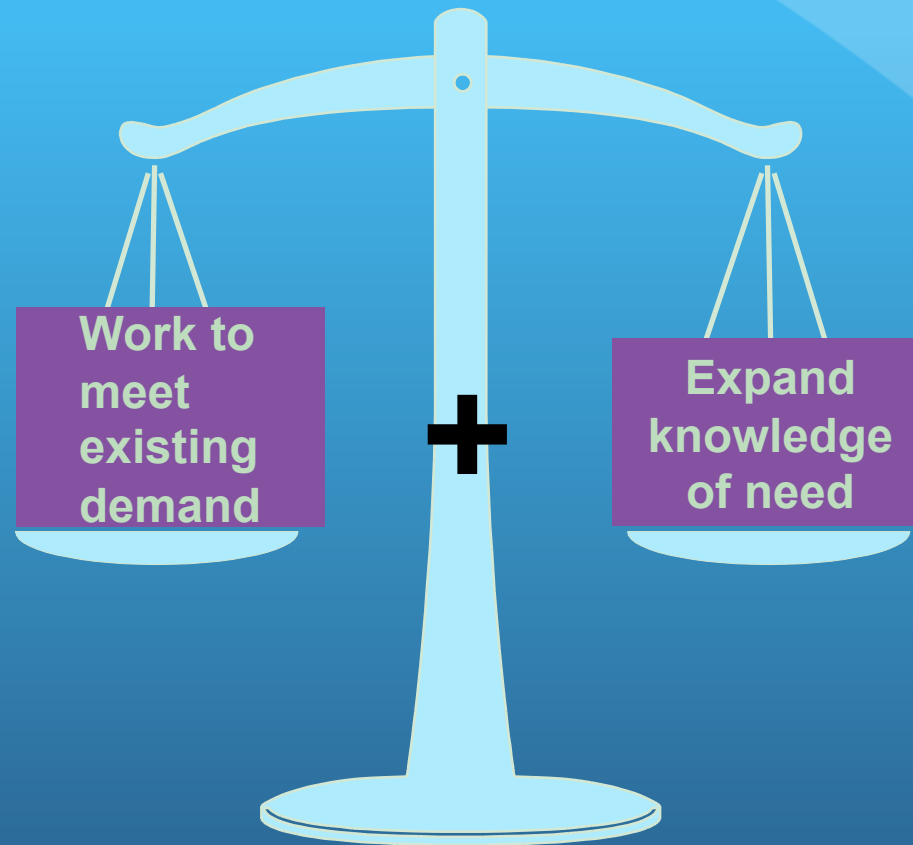
